### **ISSUE STATEMENT(S):**

Did the Employer violate Article 13.1, 13.2, 19.1 or 19.2 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement (CBA) by assigning the duty of trash run to response and movement officers? If so, what is the appropriate remedy?

### **AWARD:**

The Arbitrator, Timothy D.W. Williams, found that the Employer did not violate Article 13.2, 13.2, 19.1 or 19.2 by assigning the duty of trash run to response and movement officers. The grievance was denied.
