SUBJECT: ALLOTMENT INSTRUCTIONS FOR 2020 SUPPLEMENTAL OPERATING, CAPITAL AND TRANSPORTATION BUDGETS

Governor Inslee has signed the 2020 supplemental budgets:

- Operating Engrossed Substitute Senate Bill 6168
- Capital Engrossed Substitute Senate Bill 6248
- Transportation Engrossed Substitute House Bill 2322

I am writing to ask you to submit allotment amendments to reflect the changes contained in these enacted supplemental budgets, as well as any appropriations contained in other bills.

Submittal Instructions

Agency Expenditure Authority Schedules (EA) for all supplemental appropriation changes are available through the <u>Enterprise Reporting Portal</u>. Under Expenditure Authority Reports, the "Incremental Expenditure Authority Schedule" (EAS 011, EAS 012 and EAS 013) displays the supplemental appropriation revisions. These are the amounts to include in your supplemental budget allotment packets. For more detailed allotment instructions, please refer to the <u>2019-21</u> <u>Allotment Instructions</u>.

To reflect your agency's expenditure, revenue, *optional* cash receipts, and *optional* cash disbursement allotment revisions related to these 2019-21 supplemental changes, use a packet purpose type of Operating or Capital 1st Supplemental – labeled "2020 March Supplemental."

Submittal Timeline

To allow time for review and approval, supplemental allotment amendments are due to the Office of Financial Management no later than Monday, April 20.
