Pursuant to enactment of the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act (P.L. 116-136), I hereby allocate \$40,000,000 from General Fund-Federal (Coronavirus Relief funds) to the Department of Social and Health Services to create the COVID-19 Immigrant Relief Fund. The purpose of the COVID-19 Immigrant Relief Fund is to assist Washington residents who are unable to access federal stimulus programs due to their immigration status.

According to guidance issued by the federal government on the Coronavirus Relief Funds, for a cost to be considered to have been incurred, the performance or delivery must take place by December 30, 2020, but payment can occur up to 90 days afterwards. Please submit the required allotment amendment packet to the Office of Financial Management using the "Operating Allocation" packet type. For General Fund-Federal, use expenditure authority code 7Z0.
