Subject of possible rule making: : The subject of this rulemaking relates to the Statewide all-payer health care claims database. Specifically, the rules will address the submission of claims data relating to chemical dependence/substance abuse claims. (This replaces the CR 101 filed April 18, 2017 – WSR 17-09-063)

Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject: RCW 43.371.010(3), 43.371.030(1) and 43.371.070(1)(a)

Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish: Chapter 43.371 RCW directs the Office of Financial Management (OFM) to establish a statewide all-payer health care claims database to support transparent public reporting of health care information. To accomplish this requirement, OFM is directed to establish rules defining claim and data files that suppliers must submit. There are federal rules regarding the submission and use of data related to certain chemical dependency/substance use disorder treatment claims. This rulemaking is to establish the definition and requirements related to the data that must be submitted to the APCD, and maintain compliance with federal law.

Identify other federal and state agencies that regulate this subject and the process coordinating the rule with these agencies: The Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) regulates the protections for certain chemical dependency/substance use disorder treatment claims information.
