INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY INTERN Abolished Effective July 1, 2007

<u>Definition</u>: As a summer, intermittent, or part-time intern, assists in customer support, applications development, and/or systems development, or participates in other technology related activities.

Distinguishing Characteristics: This intern position is intended to encourage "real-world" skill development for those currently enrolled in a vocational or college program in the information technology field. Work at this level is closely supervised and designed to provide training for incumbents.

Minimum Qualifications

Students of accredited colleges who have completed their freshman year or are currently enrolled in a vocational technical program in the information technology field.

Note: This class is restricted to summer, intermittent, or parttime internships for persons actively pursuing a course of study leading to an information technology related degree or equivalent certificate.
