#### BASIC FUNCTION

Propogate and care for trees, shrubs, and forage plants used in research, teaching, and/or campus landscape projects.

#### **DISTINGUISHING CHARACTERISTICS**

Under general supervision, perform nursery, greenhouse, or arboreta operations including soil analysis, receiving and shipping plants, and maintaining growth records on propagations.

### TYPICAL WORK

Recommend varieties and quantities of plants to be grown;

Diagnose and treat plant diseases and pests;

Prepare bedding areas by sterilizing and mixing soils, cleaning bedding tables and sterilizing pots and containers used in nursery culture;

Propogate plants by cutting, seeding, grafting, layering and budding;

Plan, prepare, plant, feed, water, prune and maintain flower beds and landscaped areas;

Analyze soil for pH content; take tissue samples for analysis;

Receive and ship plants, seeds and bulbs; collect seeds from plants; maintain growth records;

Control environment by regulating heat, light, shade, humidity, etc., in greenhouse or nursery;

Assist in the collection of research data or prepare teaching materials and assist in demonstrations;

May repair, maintain and operate a variety of grounds mechanical equipment, systems, and apparatus;

May direct the work of others;

Perform related duties as required. MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Three years of gardening or groundskeeping experience <u>OR</u> equivalent education/experience.
