HEAVY EQUIPMENT OPERATOR SUPERVISOR

Abolished Effective February 10, 2006

DEFINITION

Supervise heavy equipment operators, utility maintenance workers and other employees in the operation of material-moving equipment and the maintenance and alteration of plant facilities and equipment.

DISTINGUISHING CHARACTERISTICS

Positions in this class are distinguished by the requirement for supervising heavy equipment operators, utility maintenance workers, and other employees in operation of material-moving equipment and the installation, maintenance, and alteration of plant facilities. This is the first level, full-time supervisor involved in facilities, equipment, and grounds maintenance.

TYPICAL WORK

Supervise heavy equipment operators, utility workers, and others engaged in the operation of trucks, tractors, powered cranes, shovels, bulldozers, snow plows, graders and similar equipment;

Supervise excavation of earth with crane, shovel, bulldozer and truck in the construction of ponds, waste dumps, landscaping and similar projects according to specifications determined by a civil engineer;

Direct the loading and movement of furniture and materials campus; direct the pick up and disposal of refuse and surplus property;

Read plans and blueprints; inspect maintenance and installation projects; determine scope of work, materials needed, and their cost and availability; assist in the development of departmental budget;

Order materials and maintain an adequate inventory of required materials to carry on maintenance work;

Select, train, and evaluate employees; participate in employee discipline; enforce safety rules and regulations;

Maintain records on work performed; write reports as required;

Perform related duties as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Tow years' full-time experience as a journey heavy equipment operator or equivalent work in street and road construction, maintenance, and repair; including one years' full-time experience as a lead, or equivalent. Possession of a valid motor vehicle operator's license may be required.

Equivalent education/experience will substitute for all minimum qualifications except when there are legal requirements, such as a license/certification/registration.

Examination Requirements:

A job element examination (including written, E & T and oral components) scored on the basis of job related experience, training, skill, ability and other elements which are established through job analysis.
