Marine engineering officers operate and maintain machinery and engineering systems aboard ship.

#### Definition:

Serve as third assistant engineering officer aboard an ocean research ship of approximately 2000 gross tons.

#### **Distinguishing Characteristics:**

Under general supervision, serve as third assistant engineering officer in the operation and maintenance of propulsion and auxiliary machinery of a diesel electric powered ocean research ship, 6000 HP.

#### **Typical Work:**

Stands engine room watch as operating engineer of propulsion or auxiliary machinery;

Directs operation of engineering department personnel as assigned;

Directs routine maintenance of deck machinery, refrigeration and air conditioning;

Maintains operating and maintenance logs and records;

Performs related duties as required.

#### Legal Requirement(s):

A U.S. Coast Guard Third Assistant Engineer's license valid for operation of a 2000 HP inspected ocean motor vessel.
