Reports need for maintenance of building to authorities;

Plants garden and cares for it, as well as flower boxes and baskets on porches;

Hangs screens in spring; cleans and stores them in fall;

Sets up chairs, tables, coat racks for parties; helps in kitchen at party time;

Performs other work as required.

Knowledge and Abilities
